A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR

Hebrews 12:1-3

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith...

Brothers and sisters in Christ, November 1 is All Saints' Day. In following our usual custom, All Saints' Sunday will be celebrated the first Sunday in November, on the 3rd. The word "saint" has a few uses in Christianity. Saint can be used to refer to a person who lived an exemplary Christian life, someone worthy of imitation, who was an exceptional vessel of God's grace. The Christian life is a life of conforming to the image of Christ, to live our lives as if Christ were living them. In God's wisdom, He also gives us worthy examples to follow. God is incarnational, and it helps to see the Christian life, the Christ-shaped life, lived in circumstances and situations that we can apply to ourselves. This is one of the reasons why, historically in the Church, someone would adopt a saint's name when becoming baptized and part of the Church.

In another sense, "saints" is used to refer to all believers, such as the way the Apostle Paul addresses the church in Ephesus (Ephesians 1:1-2). This indicates the high calling for each Christian. We are all called to be holy as God is holy. We are all called to deny ourselves, take up the cross, and follow Jesus. We are all given the sacred privilege of image-ing God through the grace of the Holy Spirit. All of you are saints - people being made holy by God's grace, to commune with God and reflect Him to the world around you.

Finally, "Saints" is also a term to describe what we proclaim in the Apostles' Creed: the communion of saints. This is the community of individuals who are no longer part of Christ's Church on earth, yet are very much part of Christ's Church, but now with Him in glory.

This communion of saints is typically what we most emphasize All Saints' Sunday. We pay our respect and give thanks to our heavenly Father for those who have passed on in the last year from the "Church Militant" (on earth) to the "Church Triumphant" (in heaven). One thing we recognize when we celebrate and give thanks for those who have "graduated to glory," is that whether we are part of the Church on earth or Church of glory, we are one body in Christ, one Church. As Charles Wesley writes in his hymn, *O Come Let Us Join Our Friends Above*, "Let saints on earth unite to sing, with those to glory gone, for all the servants of our King in earth and heaven, are one."

We are one with the great figures of the past such as Abraham, Moses, Miriam, Deborah, Joshua, Ruth, David, Nehemiah. We are one with the Apostles and the martyrs. We are not just talking about people who have died and that we are trying really hard to remember. Rather, we are talking about those who are very much alive in the presence of God, for as Jesus would remind us, "He is not God of the dead, but of the living."

Almighty God, You have knit together your elect in one communion and fellowship, in the mystical body of Your Son Christ our Lord. Grant us grace so to follow Your holy saints in all virtuous and godly living, that we may come to those unspeakable joys, which You have prepared for those who sincerely love you; through Jesus Christ our Lord. 
